GUIDELINES FOR PUBLISHING AT KIT

KIT and the Helmholtz Association are committed to open scientific research, with a baseline position on Open Access as well as an Open Science Policy and encourage all researchers to make their research results freely available on the internet.



WHICH OPEN ACCESS SERVICE SUITS ME?

The decision in favour of a publication channel entails different efforts and framework conditions. You should ask yourself the following questions in advance:

- What formal, technical and, if necessary, financial effort am I prepared to make for the preparation of my work?
- How can I guarantee that my work meets the quality requirements of the scientific community?
- How can I achieve the best possible visibility for my research results?



THE PUBLICATION SERVICES

KIT Library offers researchers at KIT two Open Access publication services with different focal points in terms of content and form:

KITpen

The KIT repository offers high standards for a sustainable and internationally networked service infrastructure.

The scientific publishing house of KIT offers high standards for publication processes, technical principles and best practices in publishing.

- Proceedings
- Publication series
- Open Access journals at KIT

A comparison of the two publication services is provided in the following table.





Target groups	PhD students, researchers and lecturers of KIT.	Heads of departments as editors of publication series as well as researchers with individual high-quality publications.
Visibility	Electronic publication with a persistent identifier (DOI) and indexing via search engines. Well-prepared metadata increases visibility.	Our publishing house is part of an international network of professional societies, research institutions and open access platforms, so in order to achieve the best possible visibility of high-quality research content.
Content	At KIT, publications must be prepared according to the guidelines of good scientific practice. The library supports you in all questions concerning the publication process.	Our publishing house makes the processes of reviewing manuscripts transparent. The reviewing process is differentiated according to different publication types.
Open Access policy	We recommend to distribute with Creative Commons licenses to increase visibility and secure terms for reuse.	Publications must be published with an open Creative Commons license (CC BY or CC BY-SA).
ORCID	The publication services are networked with the international research profile ORCID. We recommend authors to use this service.	For publishing, an ORCID of the author is mandatory.
Manuscript	You will find document templates for Word and TeX in the Toolbox.	Publications must comply with the KIT Scientific Publishing design guidelines.
Typesetting and layout	Consulting and training on format templates and editors for scientific writing (including SciFlow).	Assist authors with manuscript revision and typesetting work in XML editors.
Publication formats	PDF for texts; MP4 for AV files, various formats for research data.	Our publishing house provides professional distribution of publications in several formats (HTML, PDF, ePUB). The authors are involved in the production processes.
Print copies	Done via the KIT printing services.	Print on demand in the international book trade.
Publication costs	Free basic service.	Publication costs are incurred for certain types of publications (especially dissertations).
