As an academic publisher, KIT Scientific Publishing attaches particular importance to the high quality of the scientific works it publishes. All publications by KIT Scientific Publishing therefore must have undergone a thorough peer review process. Since KIT Scientific Publishing exclusively publishes titles from researchers affiliated to Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) the peer review of our publications is executed by the academic community which also is in charge of assigning external reviewers.

KIT Scientific Publishing reserves the right to reject publication proposals from authors who are not affiliated to KIT and where the quality of the publication can therefore not be assured. All KIT affiliate researchers pledge to adhere to the Rules for Safeguarding Good Scientific Practice at KIT (see http://www.kit.edu/downloads/gute_wiss_praxis_en.pdf). The rules state that reviewers of scientific work shall use a transparent evaluation system and retain their independence as examiner/s. This shall also include unprejudiced evaluation.

For KIT Scientific Publishing titles appearing in book series, the editors select which titles fulfill the series quality requirements and thus may appear in the book series.

Concerning Monographs which are not published within a series the peer reviewing is guarenteed by KIT Scientific Publishing through external reviewers.
